

Sewing Pattern — Bolero 5052

Recommendations on fabric: soft wool/bouclé

You will also need: soft wool/bouclé

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Facing:

- 1. Back part 1 folded detail
- 2. Front part 2 details

Lining:

- 1. Back part 1 folded detail
- 2. Front part 2 details

Fusing:

- 1. Back part 1 folded detail
- 2. Front part 2 details

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Stitch shoulder seams into outer/inner parts of the garment; doing this, ease back shoulder edges between marks.
- 2. Stitch front/back darts diagonally reducing to zero. Tie threads' ends at darts' tops, press dart depths toward center.
- 3. Pin jacket's inner details on outer ones (reinforced with the fusing) right sides together. Shoulder seams and darts must meet. Stitch together along lower edges, front edges, neckline edges and



sleeve hem edges. Finish the stitch strictly at side seams' marking. Cut allowances to 0.5 cm width, make several slashes into roundings to stitch line; cut diagonally at front corners. Turn the garment right side out through open side seam.

- 4. Stitch side seams into fabric jacket. Press seams apart. Turn lining jacket's side seam allowances into wrong side, sew edges by hand.
- 5. Topstitch lower edges, front edges, neckline edges, sleeve lower edges along edges on right side.
