

## Sewing Pattern — Uniform jacket 6090

Recommendations on fabric: serviceable wearproof mixed fabric.

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



### **CUTTING:**

(On the pattern pieces, “beam” means straight of grain. Lay out your pieces accordingly. Some pieces will be cut on the fold. This is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.)

#### Main fabric:

1. Collar – 2 folded pieces
2. Stand-up collar – 2 folded pieces
3. Yoke – 2 folded pieces
4. Patch pocket – 2 pieces
5. Patch pocket's flap – 4 pieces
6. Loop – 1 piece
7. Back waistband – 1 folded piece
8. Front waistband – 2 pieces
9. Left front part – 1 piece
10. Right front part – 1 piece
11. Upper sleeve – 2 pieces
12. Lower sleeve – 2 pieces
13. Back part – 1 folded piece
14. Cuff – 4 pieces
15. Sleeve slit facing – 2 pieces

**APPEARANCE:**

Uniform jacket for men with center buttoned closure and back yoke. Front parts: two upper pockets with snapped flaps. Set-in two-seamed sleeves with snapped cuffs. Turn-down collar with stand-up detail. Shoulders: loops for epaulettes. Jacket lower part: stitch waistband gathered with elastic braid at sides.
