

Sewing Pattern — Trousers 6048

Recommendations on fabric: linen of 150 cm width; a cord

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

<u>Attention</u>! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Main fabric: 1. Front part – 2 pieces 2. Back part – 2 pieces

INSTRUCTIONS:

Sew side and inside leg seams. Press allowances apart, the, tack them.

Insert parts one into another, right sides together, sew the middle seam.

Make eyelets for the cord into front parts' waistband.

Press the one-piece facing to wrong side, turn the allowance under and topstitch on 0.1 cm from the bending. Pull the cord.

Press the hem to wrong side, then topstitch.
