

Sewing Pattern — Jacket 6036

Recommendations on fabric: thick cloth with acid-proof dipping

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Main fabric:

3. Upper pocket – 1 piece
4. Front part – 2 pieces
5. Collar – 1 folded piece
7. Upper sleeve – 2 pieces
8. Lower sleeve – 2 pieces
9. Back part – 2 pieces

Lining:

1. Front band – 1 folded piece
2. Sacking – 4 pieces
6. Stand-up collar – 1 folded piece

APPEARANCE:

Acid-proof jacket with center buttoned closure. Turn-down collar. Set-in double-seamed sleeves. Two pockets into side seams and one patch upper front pocket. Collar with cotton lap.

TECHNICAL DRAWING:
