

Sewing Pattern — Uniform trousers 6032

Recommendations on fabric: serviceable wearproof mixed fabric

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Main fabric:

2. Button catch – 1 folded piece
3. Side front leg – 2 pieces
4. Left waistband – 1 piece
5. Right waistband – 1 piece
6. Back flap – 4 pieces
8. Back pocket valance – 2 pieces
9. Back pocket facing – 4 pieces
10. Patch pocket – 2 pieces
11. Flap – 4 pieces
12. Belt loop – 1 piece
13. Front leg – 2 pieces
14. Back leg – 2 pieces

Lining:

1. Front sacking – 2 folded pieces
7. Back pocket – 2 pieces

APPEARANCE:

Straight trousers with zipper closure, stitched waistband and belt loops. Front legs: two pockets with cut sides and two patch pockets with snapped flaps. Back legs: two slit pockets with snapped flaps.
