

## Sewing Pattern — Poncho 4480

Recommendations on fabric: natural or mixed costume fabric

You will also need: fusible interfacing, lining, thin shoulder pads, separable zipper, 2 decorative clasps

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

**Note:** By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam allowance: all seams - 1 cm, hem of poncho – 3 cm, hem of cape – 2 cm.

Attention! First of all, please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.



### **CUTTING:**

#### Fabric:

1. Center back - cut 2
  2. Side back - cut 2
  3. Center front –cut 2
  4. Side front – cut 2
  5. Front facing - cut 2
  6. Back neck facing – cut 1
  7. Front cape - cut 2
  8. Back cape – cut 2
  9. Belt loops – cut 1
  10. Front belt – cut 2
- Back belt – cut 2

Lining details are cut using main fabric patterns excluding back neck facing and front facing.

#### Lining:

1. Center back – cut 2
2. Side back – cut 2
3. Side front – cut 2
4. Center front – cut 2

Fusible interfacing: front facing, back neck facing

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Apply fusible interfacing to listed details. Apply extra fusible band along back neckline.
2. Fold belt in half lengthwise wrong side out and stitch on one short and long sides. Trim seams, turn belt out and press. Do the same with the second belt.
3. Sew dart on center back and press toward center. Sew center and side backs, inserting back belt into the seam. Press apart seams. Sew back center seam. Press apart the seam.
4. Sew center and side fronts, inserting front belt into the seam. Press seam toward center..
5. Sew shoulder and side edges of poncho. Press apart seams.
6. Serge one long edge of the loop belt. Press unserged edge inside, overlapping it with serged edge. Put double stitch along the edges. Cut belt loop in 2 parts. Sew belt loops near side seams.
7. Sew shoulder edges of the cape. Serge and press apart seams. Sew back center edge. Serge and press apart seam. Serge lower edge of cape, fold inside and topstitch at 1.5 cm from the edge. Place cape on poncho, match and pin edges of front facing and neck.
8. Sew and press apart shoulder edges of back neck and front facing. Sew zipper to front bands. Place front facing and neck facing on poncho, pin along edges and stitch on neckline and front bands. Clip seams in corners, turn right side out and press.
9. Sew lining details the same way as main fabric details, leaving an opening in left side seam. Sew lining to neck facing and front bands. Stitch armhole in two steps: first front, then back. Sew lining to hem of poncho. Turn poncho out. Sew the opening closed.
10. Set clasp into back belt and fasten the end. Put decorative stitch along front band and neckline. Attach back cape to center seam at waist level by hand.
