

Sewing Pattern — Bolero 4104

Recommendations on fabric: silk satin fabrics of natural or mixed fibers.

You will also need: elastic yarn 3 cm wide (the approximate length is mentioned on the back part pattern), elastic yarn 0.5 cm wide.

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

Seam allowance: all seams - 1 cm, along the lower edge of sleeve — 2 cm

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Fabric:

1. Back part – 1 detail
2. Sleeve – 2 details
4. Panel – 1 detail

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Sew edge of sleeve. Serge and press onto back part. Turn hem of sleeve twice inside at 1 cm. and topstitch, leaving a slit for elastic yarn. Run the elastic yarn and fix ends.
2. Sew back part of sleeve in armhole of back part. Serge and press onto sleeve.
3. Stitch loosely on top edge of back part and front part of sleeve and gather ruffles.
4. Sew panel into ring. Fold panel in half lengthwise and press. Fix ends of elastic yarn. Run the elastic yarn into panel. Fix panel to bolero stretching the elastic yarn. Stitch panel (panel seam is near left side of edge). Serge panel connecting seam.
