

Sewing Pattern — Dress 5955

Recommendations on fabric: costume fabrics of natural or mixed fibers

You will also need: interfacing, 4 buttons, lining

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam allowance : all seams - 1 cm

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Fabric:

1. Center back – 2 details
2. Side back – 2 details
3. Center front - 2 details
4. Side front – 2 details
5. Button stand – 2 details
6. Strap – 2 details

Lining:

1. Center back – 2 details
2. Side back – 2 details
3. Front - 2 details
4. Side front – 2 details

Use main fabric pattern pieces to cut out lining details except for the front part.

Fusing: Button stand

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Apply interfacing to button stand.
2. Sew princess edges of front. Press seams towards center of front.

3. Fold strap in half lengthwise right sides together and overstretch long and one short sides. Turn strap out, trimming in corners and press.
4. Sew center edge of back. Press seam to left side. Sew princess seams on back, inserting strap according to marks. Press seams towards center of back.
5. Sew shoulder and side edges. Press seams towards back.
6. Sew details of lining the same way as main fabric details, leaving a slit in left side seam. Stitch lining to button stands. Fold garment with lining right sides together and overstretch on front edges, neckline and hem.
7. Overstretch armhole in two steps: armhole of back from shoulder seam up to side seam; and armhole of front from shoulder seam up to side seam through the slit in side seam. Sew the slit closed.
8. Serge buttonholes on right front sew buttons on left front.
