

Sewing Pattern — Jacket 4233

Recommendations on fabric: natural or mixed thin costume fabric

You will also need: fusing; lining; shoulder pads, sleeve heads; hooks and eyelets (5 pcs) .

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

Seam allowance: all seams - 1 cm, hem of sleeve - 3 cm

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Main fabric:

1. Central back part – 2 details
2. Side back part – 2 details
3. Central front part – 2 details
4. Side front part – 2 details
5. Stand-up part of collar — 2 details
6. Sleeve – 2 details
7. Back neckline facing – 1 detail
8. Buttonstand – 2 details
9. Decorative front – 4 details
10. Basque — 1 folded detail

Lining:

1. Central back part – 2 details
2. Central front part – 2 details
3. Side back part – 2 details (use main fabric pattern)
4. Side front part — 2 details (use main fabric pattern)
5. Sleeve – 2 details (use main fabric pattern)

Fusing: central front part, back part neckline facing, hem of sleeve, buttonstand, stand-up collar.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Apply fusing to details . Apply fusing to the back part neckline and hem of sleeve.
2. Sew darts on back part, press depths towards center. Sew princess edges on back part . Press apart the seam. Sew center edge of back part. Press seam allowance apart.
3. Fold details of decorative front part right sides together and overstitch along fly rounded edge between round markers. Slash seam allowance near marker. Turn details onto right side. Sew princess edge of front part, inserting decorative front part. Align neckline edges. (extended neckline edge stays free). Shape free neckline part with five pleats and fix with the stitch at 0.5 cm. Off the edge.
4. Sew and press apart side and shoulder edges of the jacket.
5. Sew sleeve seam. Press seam allowance onto back part. Sew sleeve into armhole according to notches. Sew in shoulder pads, sew sleeve heads.
6. Sew outer stand-up part of collar into the neckline. Press the seam apart.
7. Sew seams on lining details and sew in sleeves, leaving a slit in sleeve seam. Sew shoulder seams of buttonstands and facing. Press the seam apart. Stitch lining to buttonstands and facing. Sew inner stand-up part of collar into the neckline. Press seam allowance apart.
8. Make pleats on basque. Fix them with the stitch at 0.5 cm off the edge. Sew basque bands. Turn onto right side.
9. Fold garment right sides together and overstitch along buttonstand and stand-up collar. Sew lower edge of main garment and lining together, inserting the basque between them. Turn jacket onto right side, straighten seams. Through the slit in sleeve fix together outer and inner stand-up collars connecting seams. Stitch lining to hem of sleeve. Sew the slit.
10. Sew hooks and eyelets.
